Muscle memory is interesting. It is the phenomenon of being able to do something that is complicated without having to think about it. We develop muscle memory by the repetitions we do physically and mentally. Watch a child learning to walk and then see how easily you walk. Remember how you learned manners and being polite to others. Now you say "Thank you" automatically. There have been occasions when I could not spell a word, but when my hands touched the keyboard my fingers moved almost magically

Habit is another word that can be used to describe doing something repeatedly. We all have habits, some are good, some bad. It is said that you must repeat a practice for thirty days for it to become a habit or for a good habit to replace a bad habit. We build both our muscle and mental memory.

A problem that can happen with our good habits is we forget why we are doing it and it becomes vain repetition. Church attendance that is mindless, is not worshiping your God. Taking children without sharing our purpose to glorify God, is just routine to them. Prayer at bedtime or before a meal that had meaning when we first said it, may become empty of meaning after the one thousandth time.

So we have a problem. We want to have good practices in our life. So much so that they become second nature to us. They are us and we are them—good, holy. But, we do not want our efforts to serve God and follow our Lord Jesus to become meaningless.

Disciples assemble with the Saints on the first day of the week to worship, remember the death, burial, resurrection and return of Jesus the Christ and to encourage our sisters and brothers in Christ. We must focus on our purpose: pay attention, pray, sing—worship. Don't arrive late and leave early, look around and speak to anyone sitting along, or one who is struggling with life or faith issues.

It is wonderful when the spiritual growth of a disciple makes them live as if Jesus is right beside them. When that disciple lives godly in an almost natural way, as if that is who they have always been. This is our goal, to be Christlike all the time. Intentional and not just automatic memory or habit.

Grief counselor Alan Wolfelt explains that walking alongside — "companioning" — one who grieves "is not about assessing, analyzing, fixing or resolving another's grief. Instead, it is about being totally present to the mourner, even being a temporary guardian of [his or] her soul."

Among Wolfelt's 11 tenets for "companioning the bereaved":

- It's about being present to another person's pain, not taking it away.
- It's about listening with the heart, not analyzing with the head.
- It's about walking alongside, not leading.
