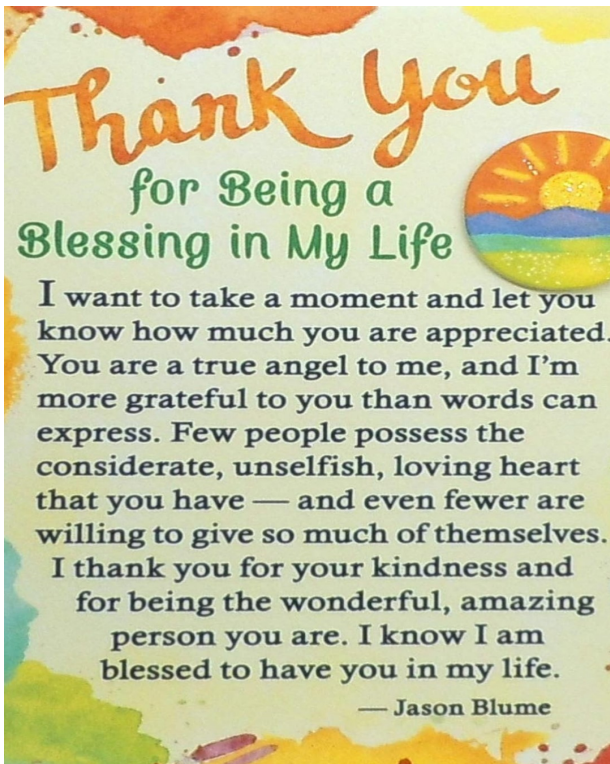

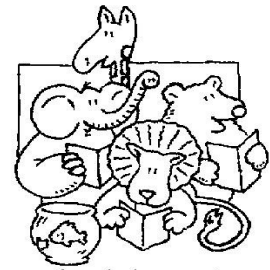

The parable of the Good Samaritan is well known, even to those who are not disciples of Jesus. In almost any group of people you can say “good Samaritan” and everyone understands. Generally, we would say it teaches that we are to be nice to others. However, there another understanding we should consider.

The previous verses are of the 72 disciples being sent to proclaim the “*Kingdom of God is near.*” They are telling the Good News or Gospel. The following verses are about Martha and Mary, with Jesus teaching us to choose the better path. Between these the dying man.

What do they all have in common? The Good News and following Jesus. They are about evangelism. The world is lost and dying in sin. Our role is not to be good housekeepers at church or to avoid associating with sinners. Our role is to tell others about the Good News of Jesus. It is the Gospel the 72 took into their society and it is the Gospel we spare no effort or expense to share with the lost.

Fortunately, it is rare that we come across a person that is beaten and bleeding on the side of the road. BUT, you cannot leave your home without passing those who are lost and dying in sin. If you met a person who was bleeding profusely from their forehead without seeming to notice, you would say something. Even if they said, “I’m all right.” You would insist on helping. We need to take our responsibility of sharing the Gospel – seriously.

Strangely, we look at the world with worldly eyes and assume they are fine. The neighbors have a nice house and car, the lawn is nicely groomed and their clothes are always clean and freshly ironed. Our friends, likewise, have the well-behaved children and seem happy. We may even wish we were more like them. They all need the Gospel of Jesus and we are the Good Samaritans. Go and do likewise.
